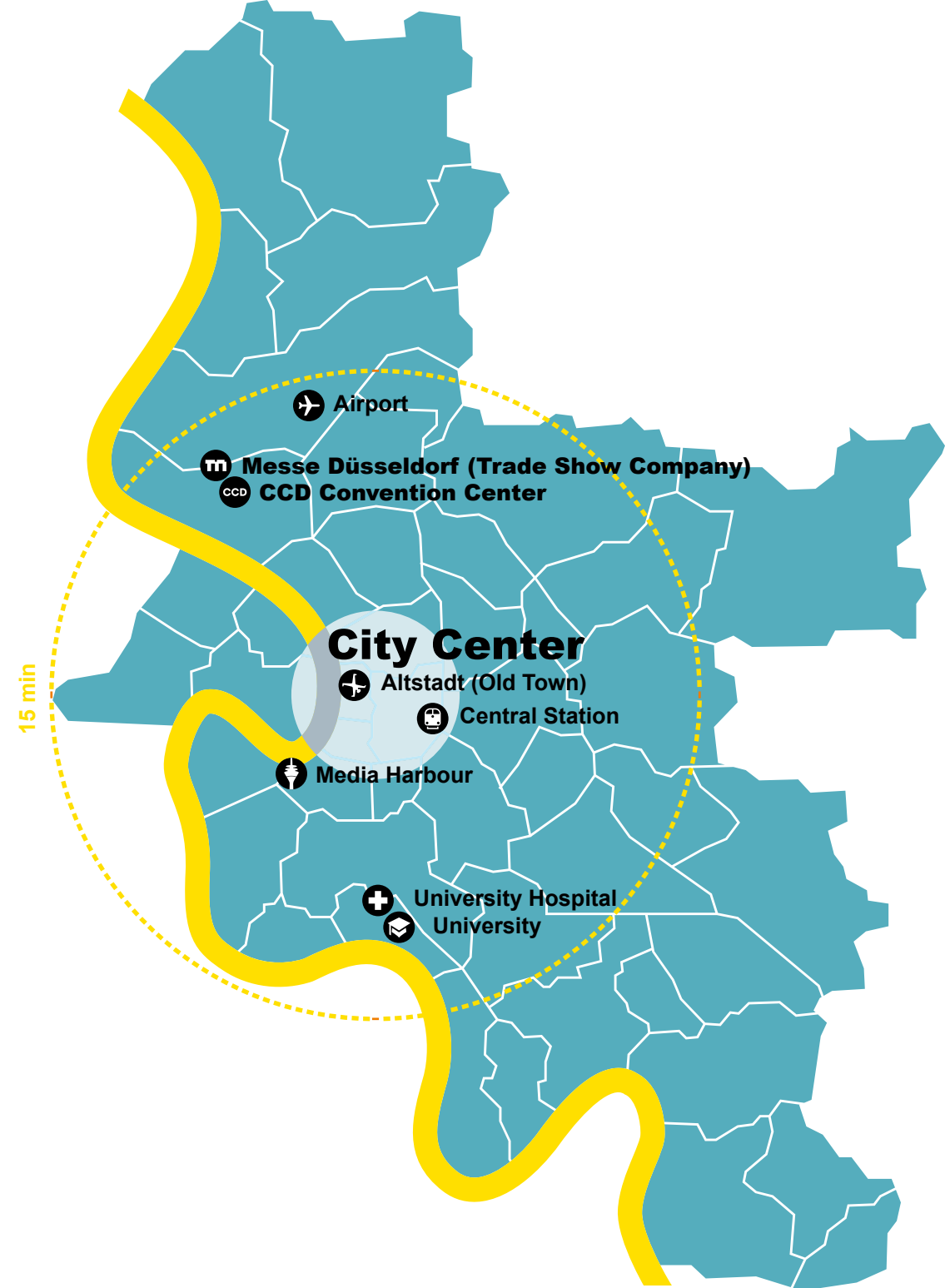
The proximity of the airport to the center is unique in Germany.



Founded 1896, the Rheinbahn (Rhine railway) is the most important local traffic provider. Transporting 550,000 people every day the company is connecting Düsseldorf with neighboring cities and provides easy and fast transportation for everyone in Düsseldorf. Whether you need a local bus, scenic tram or a fast subway, the Rheinbahn provides modern transport equipment and exceptional train stations at any time. With the opening of the Wehrhahnlinie (Wehrhahn line) the last blank space in the local traffic network was closed and even the New York Times wrote an article about the "Art and 3D Magic in a German Subway". If you want to explore these outstanding stations and their art installations, you can just take the subway or join one of the guided subway art tours hosted by Düsseldorf Tourism.



When you are flying to or from Düsseldorf you can choose between 70 different airlines, carrying over 25 million passengers a year. The airport provides direct flights to every major European city and intercontinental connections to Asia, America and Africa. Located only 6 kilometers from downtown Düsseldorf and only 3 kilometers from the fairgrounds and the Congress Center you will not find any airport as close to your destinations as this one. The airport has direct train and bus connections to the main station in the city, to the fairgrounds, the Convention Center and is connected by an automated transportation system to its own high-speed train station.

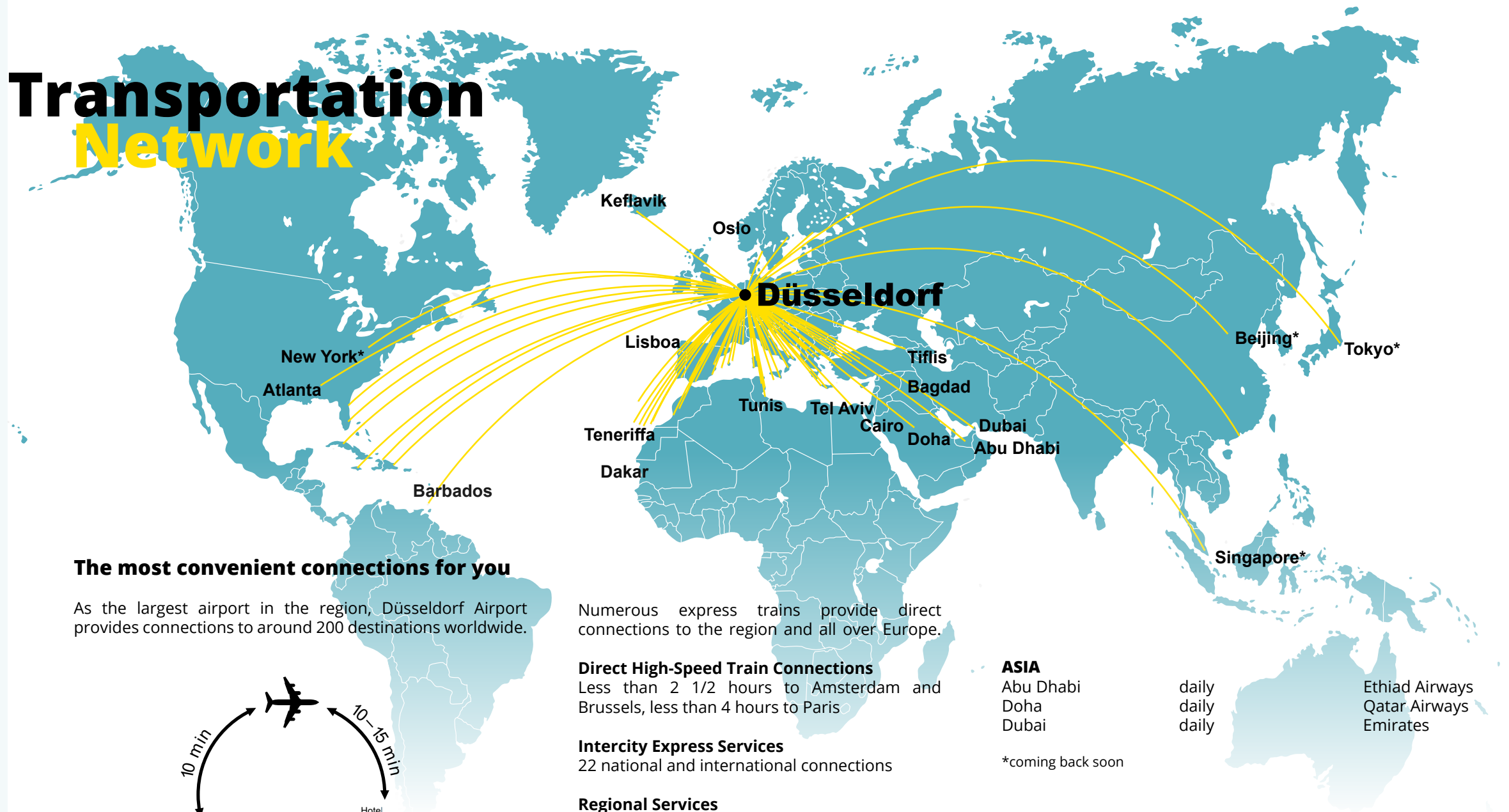

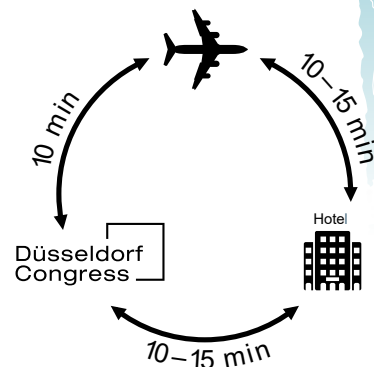

Visa Welcome to Germany

Germany is a well known and loved tourist destination and being part of the TOP10 of the most popular tourist destinations worldwide is proof of that. Every year more and more people come to the country to explore the buzzing cities, dive into the history of medieval villages, explore the scenic landscape or come to do business in the fourth-largest economy of the world.

Visa regulations

Germany is part of the border-free Schengen area which guarantees free movement for more than 400 million EU citizens, along with non-EU nationals living in the EU or visiting the EU as tourists, exchange students or for business purposes. Additionally to the free movement of any attendees with an EU-nationality, Germany permits the nationals of 62 countries part of the visa waiver program to enter its territory without the need to obtain a visa first. Countries like Australia, Brazil, Chile, Canada, Israel, Japan, Mexico, Serbia, the United States or the UAE are allowed to enter Germany visa-free and remain there for a period of 90 days within 6 months.

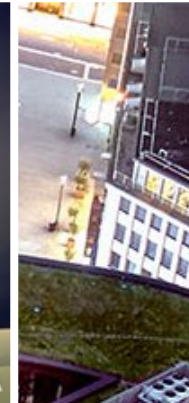
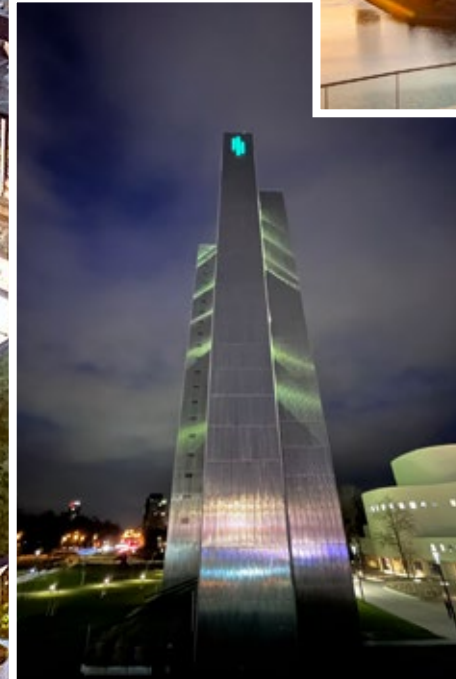


Must-See Sights

But there are more sights to be checked out, including highlights like Schloss Benrath palace, the Japanese Garden in Niederkassel and the remains of the Kaiserswerth imperial palace – each of Düsseldorf's 50 districts has its special places that are definitely worth a visit.



Düsseldorf is brimming with high-caliber architecture: the Gehry buildings lining the Media Harbor and the “Kö-Bogen” by Daniel Libeskind are just two of the most prominent examples. The Düsseldorf Rhine Tower, a television tower, is the local landmark of the city; together with the iconic “Rheinkniebrücke” bridge, it dominates the city’s skyline.

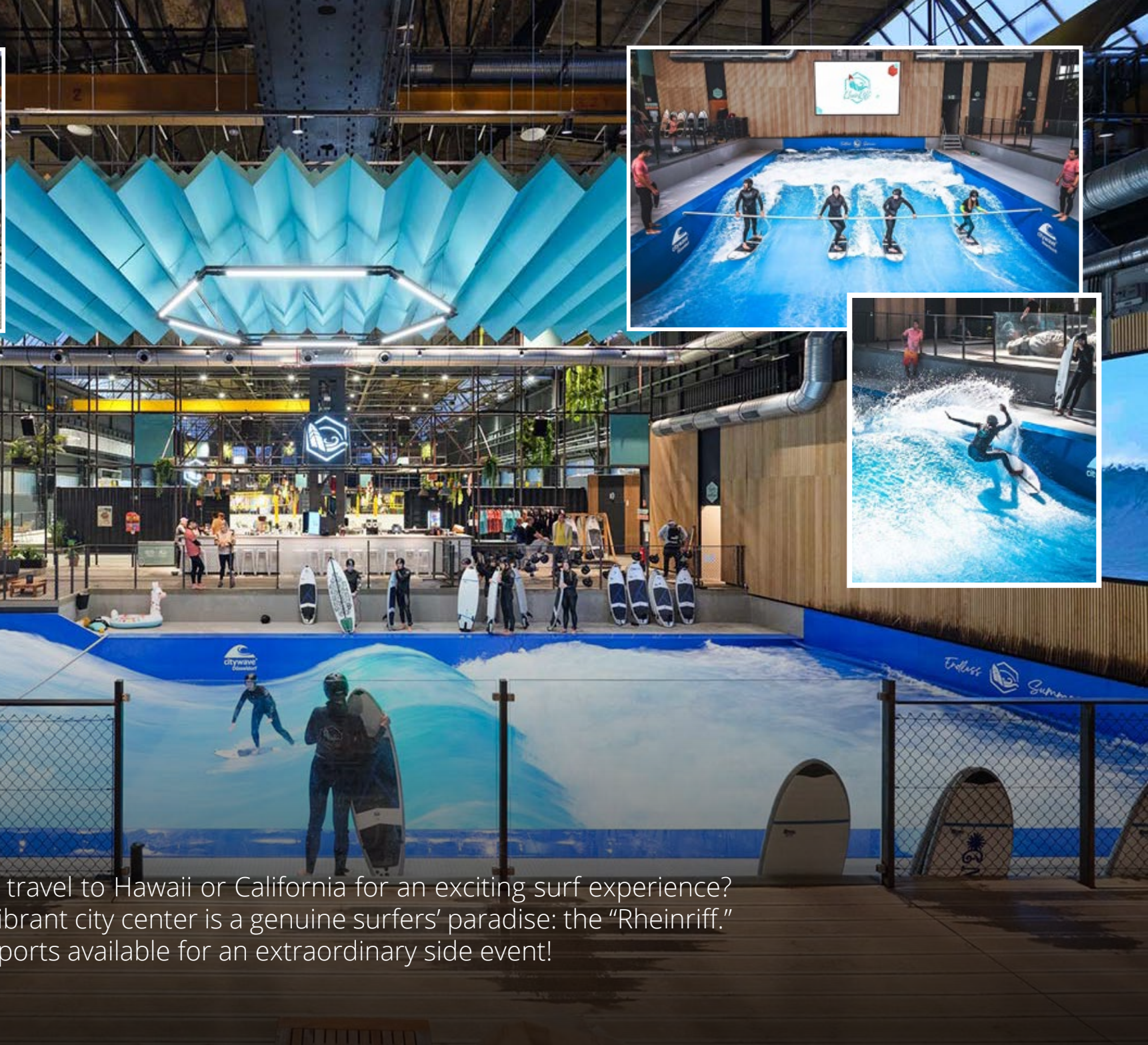
Japan on the Rhine

Let's Go Surfing

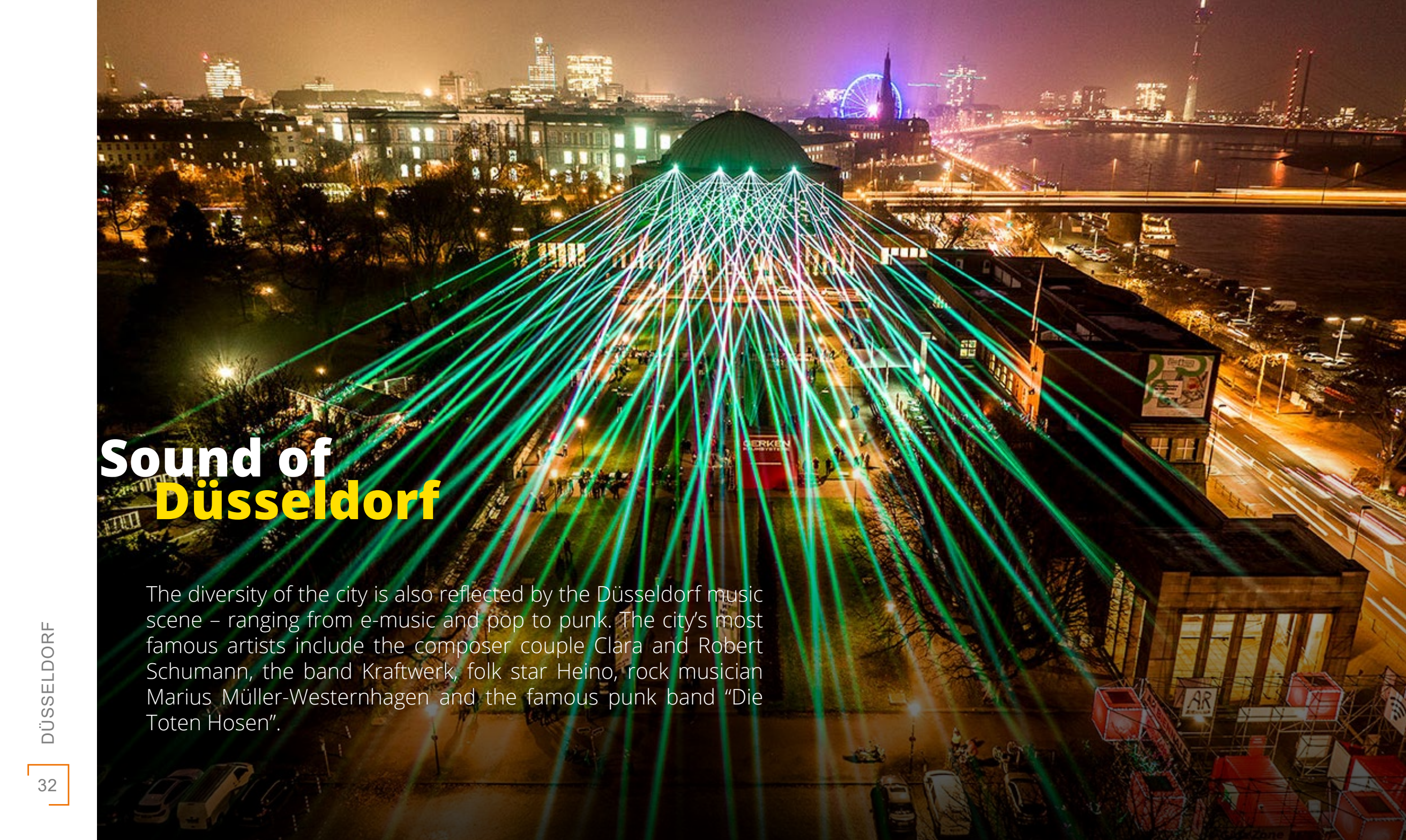

Located directly on the Rhine river and connected to the Messe Düsseldorf premises and situated only 3 km away from Germany's third biggest airport and only 5 km from Old Town, the complex of CCD Congress Center Düsseldorf buildings links up with the adjacent exhibition halls to form a flexible room concept for up to 22,500 attendees.

Business Starts in Düsseldorf

Be it conventions, annual general meetings, conferences, corporate presentations, exhibitions, virtual and hybrid events, or workshops, CCD Congress Center Düsseldorf offers you made-to-measure rooms for any event.

The Congress Center has 41 rooms, seating up to 2,000 attendees in the biggest room, and an exhibition area of 11,000 sqm. Thanks to the direct access to the Messe Düsseldorf site and the adjacent exhibition halls 1 and 3, the total capacity of the CCD can be expanded from 7,500 attendees to 22,500 attendees. The two adjacent exhibition halls each dispose of 34,000 sqm of additional exhibition area.

The Congress Center's modular room concept as well as two separately usable entrances – CCD Süd and CCD Stadthalle – make for a highly flexible occupancy of the Congress Center, permitting just about any desired space combination for individual events.

Recommendations for planning, organizing and holding sustainable events at CCD Congress Center Düsseldorf.

As an operator we attach great importance to ecological and socially responsible behavior and management. Jointly with our customers as well as our partner companies and service providers we would like to embark upon the journey to more sustainable events.



TIP: A well-developed and scenic cycle path runs along the banks of the Rhine, providing easy access to the CCD Congress Center Düsseldorf – either on your own bike or on one rented from a sharing provider. The Congress Center has several hundreds of cycle parking spaces across the complete premises.



Signage for local public transport stops: Clear signposting for the nearest bus, tram and train stops eases public transport use for you. We have made sure that you can easily find your way.



Car/ Bus Park guidance system: If you travel by car or bus, please follow our parking guidance system. This not only helps us to save emissions but also prevents disruptions to local transport and residents.



Parking space layout for different user groups: We have made sure that our parking spaces are appropriate for different user groups. There are special parking spaces for people with disabilities, car sharing and e-vehicles.



Cycle parking spaces: For eco-conscious visitors we offer cycle parking spaces. If you wish to come by bike, rest assured you will be able to park it safely.



Arrival and directions: In your invitations you will find explicit instructions on how to use environmentally friendly means of transport such as rail and local public transport (ÖPNV). Feel free to use the timetable information for these means of transport to help plan your journey.



Electricity from renewable sources: We bank on electricity from renewables by selecting a green power provider. This way we promote environmentally friendly energy usage and make our contribution to climate protection.



Room temperature limited to max. 20°C: To reduce energy consumption all venue rooms should not exceed 20°C room temperature. This measure helps to cut emissions and save resources.



Temperature reduced at night: Reducing temperature at night saves emissions and energy. Therefore, we ensure heating is turned down in the venue overnight to guarantee greater energy efficiency.



Cooling limited to max. 6 degrees below outdoor temperature: To optimize energy consumption all venues should not be cooled to more than 6 degrees below outdoor temperature. This measure helps to cut energy consumption and save the environment.



Sorting our kitchen waste: With efficient waste disposal in mind, we collect and sort kitchen waste, especially spent cooking oil from deep fat fryers. This makes for environment-compliant disposal and contributes to a sustainable use of resources.



Use of reusable crockery, cutlery and glasses: To reduce plastic waste we use nothing but reusable crockery, cutlery and glasses. Enjoy your food and beverages in an eco-friendly setting.



Sparing use of cleaning agents: In co-operation with our cleaning companies, we make arrangements to use cleaning agents sparingly. If necessary, we offer further training for cleaning staff to ensure efficient and environmentally friendly use.



Use of environment-compliant cleaning agents: Our cleaning practices are environment-conscious. We bank on cleaning agents that bear the „Blue Angel“ environmental seal or the European Environmental Symbol and/or comply with their criteria. This way we guarantee cleanliness and hygiene without burdening the environment.



Installation of a central service center for event management: We have set up a central service center for the efficient organization of events, also in terms of sustainability aspects. This central event management office takes care of the entire organization and is available to answer any questions you may have. We ensure that sustainability aspects are taken into account at every event.

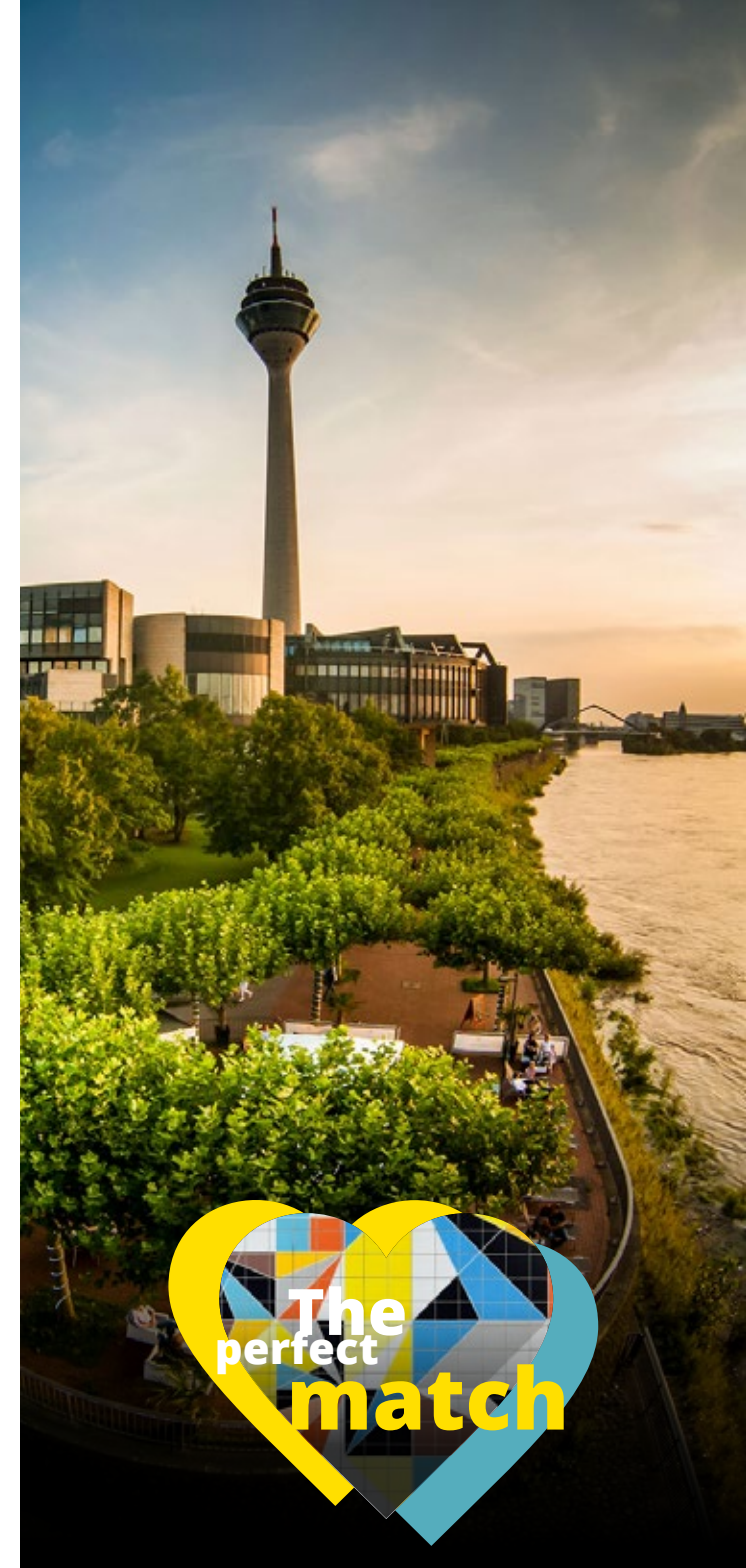
